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Vulnerability

A remote attacker could update the source project file (TPG) stored into the TBox by a malicious one so that code could be executed on machine executing TWinSoft when an engineer download it.

Vulnerable Products

This vulnerability affects TWinSoft releases 12.4 and earlier.

Solution

A first aspect of the solution is explained in **TBOX-SA-2021-0004** as the provided solution will forbid any unauthenticated user to update source project file into the TBox.

A new version of TWinSoft have also been released to avoid code execution.

It will now extract the source project files exclusively to the output directory, whatever the location of the referenced files were when the source project file was created.

So we advise to update to a version 12.5 or later of TWinSoft.

Workaround

There are no workaround available for this vulnerability.
